Amedeo Pierangeli, 55, 1402 60th St., who died at Kenosha hospital Monday from injuries suffered June 5 in an accident, was born in Ascoli-Piceno, Italy, Jan. 1, 1894, a son of the late Phillip and Clella Branconi Pierangeli.
