Former city grocer victim of brief illness

Ladislao (Lallo) Pierangeli, 72, 5105 22nd Ave., well-known former grocer in this community, died at St. Catherine Hospital this morning following a one-month illness.

Mr. Pierangeli had operated a grocery store at 5101 22nd Ave. from 1922 until his retirement in 1960. He was born in Montegalfo, Ascoli-Piceno, Italy, on June 16, 1892. His parents were the late Mr. and Mrs. Philip Pierangeli. In 1909, he came to this country and was employed by the Simmons Co. here until 1922.

The deceased was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church and the Holy Name Society of the parish. He also was a member of the Italian-American Society and the Wisconsin Retail Food Dealers Association.

On Sept. 9, 1914, he married Miss Pasquina Rossini. In addition to his widow, he is sur-
