## **Pierangeli market should be remembered**

There was another great mom and pop, family owned independent grocery store in Kenosha. Pierangeli and Sons grocery store and meat market was located on the corner of 22nd Avenue and 51st Street.

Ladislao and Pasquina Pierangeli owned and operated the store from the late 1920s until 1960 when they retired. The store was known for fresh-dressed poultry and fresh eggs. Ladislao would go out each week to local farms and pick up chickens and eggs for the store.

Each Thanksgiving and Christmas, the store would have fresh turkeys and ducks. Children attending Bain school would come to see the live turkeys. Although times were difficult during the Great Depression, Ladislao and Pasquina provided assistance to neighborhood families that were in need.
